Kyoto International Performing Arts Festival 2020Notice of Postponement

Due to the spread of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) Kyoto Experiment: Kyoto International Performing Arts Festival 2020, the 11th edition of the festival originally scheduled to take place this Autumn, will be postponed to February 3rd (Weds) - March 28th (Sun) 2021 and held with the name Kyoto Experiment: Kyoto International Performing Arts Festival Spring 2021. The decision to postpone Kyoto Experiment is due to the global spread of the coronavirus disease and the impact this has on restrictions of movement of the festival's participating artists as well as in securing time for the creation of new work. The festival will be held whilst ensuring strict measures are taken to prevent the spread of the coronavirus disease. The announcement of the full program is scheduled for mid November.

Director's Message


